A non-refundable Registration Fee is required and will become payable upon acceptance of a place at the College. Payment plans are available upon request.

*** An additional deposit will be required for International students**

Please note that the following payment options on the basic fee structure are available:

(Parklands College is a "cash free" zone, parents are kindly requested not to pay fees in this manner. We reserve the right to recover cash deposit fees incurred)

1. **Annually:** Payable on/before 1st January.
2. **Quarterly in Advance:** Four payments by Debit Order/Authorised Credit Card to be dated the first day of each quarter, ie. 1 Jan, 1 Apr, 1 Jul, 1 Oct.
3. **Monthly in Advance:** Eleven (ten for Grade 12) monthly payments by Debit Order. The amounts to be debited on the first day of each month commencing 1 Jan to 1 Nov (Jan-Oct for Grade 12).
4. Families with three or more children at Parklands College, qualify for a different fee structure.
